The event can accommodate 125 quilters and registration will open on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. All you need to do is download the registration form and mail it ASAP with your check. All entries will be accepted by postmark date (not hand delivered), should we exceed our limit, a waiting list will be offered. The information you give us on the form is very important to us, please write legibly as there are several people who will be using it. Once I have processed your entry, I will send an email/surface mail stating you’ll be one of our campers with other pertinent information.**

**As most of you know, we had a huge fire this summer/fall and Simpson University was one of the evacuation centers which consisted of using the gym. How-ever it happened, the flooring was damaged and now it needs to be repaired. Unfortunately, the laying of the new floor is happening when school ends and throughout the summer, hoping they have it ready for the fall semester. What this presents to us is a change in sewing areas. My committee has met with the Simpson University staff and we have an alternate plan and we’re very excited to share this with you. No, we all won’t be together, we’ll have 6 different rooms in 2 different buildings that are located on the opposite side of the campus (a side we don’t usually use) but they are close to each other. We will still have plenty of sewing areas, common cutting stations for**
